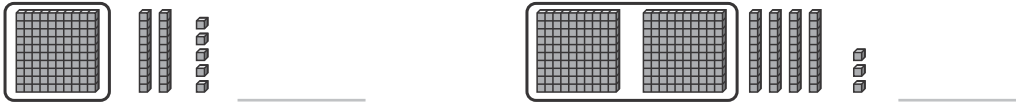


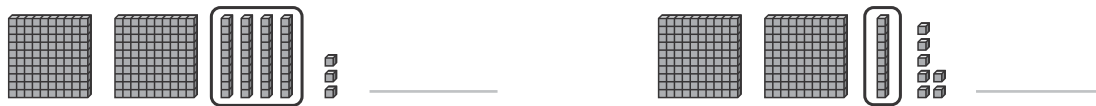
AZ Vocabulary
